Scorekeeper

REPORTS TO THE HEAD SCOREKEEPER

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

This position is required to attend and keep either score or pitch count at each game according to the team schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ability to focus on the game with the possibility of many distractions.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Arrive to field 15 minutes before game time begins.

The home team provides the scorekeeper. The scorekeeper is responsible for obtaining the lineups from both managers and entering them into Game Changer. At the end of the game, the home scorekeeper must get signatures from both managers and the umpire and then return the game summary sheet to the board member on duty or place it in the designated location.

The visitor team's scorekeeper will do the pitch count. You must collect each pitch count book from the managers. At the end of the game, you will sign the pitch count book and have both managers sign their pitch count books.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Season Commitment

Spring (February to June)

- Attend Scorekeeper Training
- 2 games per week (this can be split if there are multiple scorekeepers)
